



Phase II (2004-2006) – In Brief

- 71 subprojects, initiatives and strategic activities from Jan 2004 – Sept 30, 2006
- Enabled by a one-time, \$4.3 million (Cdn) public investment from the Government of Canada through Health Canada's, Primary Health Care Transition Fund (PHCTF)
- Overarching goals of Phase II
 - Increase Access – to primary-care providers able to support HPC locally
 - Enhance Quality – address misuse, under use and over use of resources
 - Build Capacity – strategic investments locally, provincial/territorial, national
- Approximately every \$1 of PHCTF funding levered \$3 of additional investment of direct and in-kind activity at the local level in Canada in HPC capacity-building
- Important process innovations:
 - Partnerships and collaborations which leverage, strengthen, amplify
 - Large scale, pan-Canadian community-development (Community of Practice)
 - Strategic investments which leverage/"leap frog" local/jurisdiction innovation to enable rapid deployment across multiple jurisdictions
 - Introduction of Action Science and specific Action Learning-based knowledge development processes to build education and service/system capacity as a complementary strategy to traditional clinical research processes
 - Introduction of product licensing model in Canada to support easy and rapid adoption of educational resources in accredited educational institutions, health service delivery organizations and professional assn/regulatory colleges
