> HI there- I just wanted to relay some comments from the RWC we  
> completed last weekend. It went very well- the participants were keen and  
> engaged all of the time; no one left or missed any of the sessions except  
> for one nurse on Sunday, whose grand mother died in a PCH.

> I must say that working with the new manual is a dream! It is so  
> easy to follow and it was evident to me that all of the facilitators  
> covered  
> the content with little 'ad libbing' as previously seen and we still had  
> enough time to throw in our comments/examples. In delivering the course,  
> I  
> felt more organized and way less tired/stressed at the end compared to  
> other  
> RWCs. A few of the participants still commented on being a little  
> overwhelmed by all of the content covered, but I didn't notice anybody's  
> eyes glaze over/disengage due to information overload.

> Some of the other comments I wanted to share are:  
> \* [REDACTED] sang an incredible and very appropriate song at the end of  
> the Grief and Bereavement session and I think Pallium should record it,

> \* Pallium needs to incorporate copies of the MMSE, CRS and BOMC into  
> the courseware because some of the facilitators do not have a 'blessed'  
> idea  
> what the BOMC looks like! Module 8- Delerium  
> \* We (I), changed things around a bit in Modules 5 and 6. We ran the  
> clip on the Family conference then did the theory burst on  
> Depression/Suffering. Then ran the clip on Hope and did the theory burst  
> on  
> hope. This just seemed to make sense to me and it flowed really well.

> doing this again in the Fall!
