

# Palliative Care Education

LEAP Renal is a one-day, interprofessional course that focuses on the essential competencies to provide a palliative care approach, with course modules and case studies contextualized to health care professionals who work in renal care programs.

LEAP Renal is ideal for any health care professional (e.g., physicians, nurses, pharmacists, social workers, etc.) who cares for patients with advanced renal disease or who works in renal care programs (such as dialysis units).
