

## Palliative Care Education

LEAP Long-Term Care is a two-day course that provides health care professionals with the essential skills and competencies of the palliative care approach. Course modules and case studies are contextualized to the long-term care setting.

This course takes an interprofessional approach and promotes teamwork and collaboration among different health care professionals who work in a variety of settings and organizations.

### Who is it for?

LEAP Long-Term Care is ideal for any health care professional (e.g. physicians, nurses, pharmacists, social workers, home care nurses, etc.) as well as personal support workers (PSWs) or care aides working in long-term care and nursing homes.
