Dr Sauls- are the symptom response kits available for nurses to use in the Northern Remote communities of Ontario and are there Physicians utilizing this strategy	There are kit order forms available for all of the 14 LHIN regions of the province however, the access to these in some communities will vary. There can be a variety of reasons for this variability - again, the local nature of drug delivery mechanisms.
